 For the duration of the War, at the end of which you will be discharged with all entitlements of rank. You will be required to serve for one day with the Colours, and the remainder of the period in the Army Reserve, in accordance with the provisions of the Royal Warrant dated 29th October, 1915, until such time as you may be called up by order of the Army Council. If employed with Hospitals, depots of Mounted Units, or as a Clerk, &c., you may be retained for the termination of hostilities until your services can be spared, but such retention shall not exceed six months? *Yes*
